## 5. Enrolment

### 5.1. Enrolment and Entry Fees

Registration is online at <http://www.snowwalkrun.ch>. The entire registration procedure is done by TrackMaxx. For young people (U18), the entry fee applies in brackets. The entry fee applies to the running and hiking formats.

On-site re-registrations and late registrations can only be paid for in cash or with TWINT in CHF. No debit/credit cards are accepted.

## 5.2. Included services

The entry fee includes the following services:

- Bib number
- Starter mail
- Swiss Runners Ticket
- Running catering
- Depot running baggage
- Baggage transport to the Weisshorn (participants S11)
- Free massage service
- Medical service
- Timing with passive transponder
- Start and ranking list with split times (only online as download)
- Diploma (only online as download)
- Present
- Organization fee & VAT
- Discounted pasta dish for only CHF 7.00 (pre-order possible when registration ONLINE)
- A free ride on the ABB cable car for S11 Weisshorn participants (valid only on the day of the event). To use the cable car, you must show your race number (QR code).
- Accompanying persons and caregivers of participants in the «S11 Weisshorn» program receive a 50% discount on the regular single ticket price for the Weisshorn trip.

## 5.3. Cancellation of Registration

If you are prevented from starting due to illness/accident or other reasons, the entry fee cannot be refunded and cannot be carried over to the next year.

It is recommended that participants take out cancellation insurance from the organiser when registration. This allows for the refund of the entry fee in the event of accidents or illness. The premium is 10% of the entry fee.

## 5.4. Transfer / re-registration to another category & late registration

Participants can transfer their starting place to another person for a fee of CHF 20.00 or re-register online for a different distance.

If you change your registration to a shorter distance, the difference in entry fee will not be refunded; if you change your registration to a longer distance, you have to pay it.

## 5.5. Final registration

Online registration for personalised bib numbers closes on 09th December 2025 (midnight). Online late registrations are possible until 09th January 2026 (midnight), although the bib numbers can no longer be personalised.

# 6. Starter Email and Distribution of Bib Numbers

## 6.1. Starter E-Mail

The starter e-mail contains the following information:

- Personal Bib Number
- Important information (bib number distribution, baggage depot, starting time, etc.)
- Promocode for outward and return journeys by public transport

## 6.2. Bib number distribution and where to fetch them

The bib number is not transferable and must be worn clearly visible on the chest, stomach, or leg throughout the entire race. It entitles you to access to feed stations, medical services and

baggage check. Any transfer of the personal bib number to another person is prohibited (see cancellation).

Until 30th September 2025, bib numbers can be delivered by post for an additional fee of CHF 10.00. This option is only available when registering online. After this date, bib numbers must be picked up at the bib number distribution desk on site.

The bib numbers can be collected from the Arosa Congress Hall (Poststrasse 27) as follows:

**Friday, 09th of January 2026**

4:00 – 6:00 p.m.

**Saturday, 10th of January 2026**

8:00 – 11:00 a.m.

## 7. Time measurement

### 7.1. Passiv-Transponder

The timing will be done by our partner «TrackMaxx». To ensure accurate timing, participants will receive a bib number with an integrated timing chip, which does not have to be returned.

### 7.2. Categories

For the hiking formats, a list of finishers is kept in alphabetical order without age categories.

## 8. Outward / return journey by public transport

For ecological reasons, it is highly recommended to use public transportation. This also makes the outward and return journeys as well as the journeys in the running region an unforgettable experience.

All participants benefit from a free journey by public transport from their place of residence, Swiss border station or airport to the event venue and back via GA travelcard routes in 2nd class.

With personal promo codes, a free public transport ticket for the outward journey and one for the return journey (valid for 1 calendar day in each case) in 2nd class can be printed out on **SBB**.

## 10. Running Baggage

Baggage must be inscribed for all runs with at least the bib number. Baggage tags will be provided when you pick up your bib number. The participants are responsible for picking up their baggage themselves (even if the race is abandoned, etc.). Checked baggage cannot be forwarded. The participants can hand in their baggage before the start.

### **Baggage drop-off Saturday, January 10, 2026**

8:00 a.m – 11:00 a.m. in the Arosa Congress Hall

The running baggage of the participants in the S11 for the Weisshorn must be handed in by 9:30 a.m. at the latest.

## 11. Refreshments

The distances between the posts will be 5 – 8km. The participants must therefore equip themselves with a bottle/cup and nourish themselves between the posts.

## 12. Wardrobes, Toilets and Showers

Wardrobes, showers and toilets can be found at the Start and Finish.

## 13. Lost & Found

Found objects are to be handed in or picked up on the day of the race at the finish line. They can't be kept for forwarded.

## 14. Prizes

All participants will receive a commemorative gift. No gifts will be sent later or if the race is not attended.
